



In Case Of
Emergency

Emergencies all have one thing in common. The element of surprise. If we could know when an emergency was going to happen, we would all be prepared.

Survival is based upon being prepared for the emergency. Passengers on airplanes are prepared before an emergency. All public areas have signs and instructions posted before emergencies take place. CPR is taught to people before the emergency takes place. The Heimlich maneuver is learned before the emergency of choking. Fire drills are practiced before the fire. The list could go on and on. Preparation is necessary to survive an emergency situation.

Some people experience almost every emergency and some experience only one. Some emergencies you will never experience. But one emergency everyone will experience is death.

Very few people prepare for this, and when it happens (like all emergencies) it is too late. No second chances are given. You are either prepared or not prepared.

Why not be prepared ?

It does not cost you money, time or anything that you have. In fact it is absolutely free. The Bible gives us the instructions to surviving death. Please follow these instructions:

Admit you are a sinner.

“As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one” (Romans 3:10).

Realize the penalty of sin is death.

“The wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord” (Romans 6:23).

Stop trying to pay for your sins.

“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God; not of works, lest any man should boast” (Ephesians 2:8&9).

Jesus paid for your sins by dying for you.

“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us” (Romans 5:8).

Receive Jesus Christ as your saviour.

“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation” (Romans 10:9&10).

Do it today before this emergency!

“...behold now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation” (II Corinthians 6:2).
